NORD/LB finances its first "non-recourse" wind farm in Poland

NORD/LB Norddeutsche Landesbank has carried out its first "non-recourse" financing of a wind farm in Poland. The Janikowo wind farm is located in the Kujawsko-Pomorskie region in north-central Poland and has a total capacity of 60 megawatts (MW). The joint venture is jointly operated by the Danish wind farm developer Eurowind Energy A/S and the Polish company Windbud. The park will be equipped with 30 wind turbines from the Danish manufacturer Vestas.

The financing, which also involves the Danish export credit insurer EKF, amounts to around € 80 million. It covers the construction and operational phases and includes, among other things, some long-term facilities as well as credit lines for both VAT and the debt service reserve.

"This is the first major international project we have realised with NORD/LB," says Benjamin Schmitt, Head of Project Finance at Eurowind Energy. "We were very impressed by the great professionalism of NORD/LB. With this financing, we have laid a promising foundation for further joint projects involving EKF. "

"For us it is a matter of great importance to support our customer Eurowind in their efforts to expand their activities in the Polish market," says Heiko Ludwig, Global Head Structured Finance at NORD/LB.
