

Power of Attorney

Deutsche Hypothekbank (Actien-Gesellschaft) (hereinafter also referred to as "DHB") has arranged with Norddeutsche Landesbank Girozentrale, Hanover, (hereinafter referred to as "NORD/LB") that DHB shall handle certain activities in connection with the conclusion of over-the-counter financial derivative transactions with customers of DHB and the corresponding processing. DHB's areas of responsibility include, among others, the process of customer categorisation and the conclusion of trustee agreements for collateral (hereinafter referred to as "acquired activities").

Having said this, we authorise

Deutsche Hypothekbank (Actien-Gesellschaft), Osterstraße 31, 30159 Hanover

on behalf of NORD/LB to issue and accept all declarations on legal transactions – both under the law of obligations and in terms of in rem rights – which are connected with the acquired activities.

DHB is released from the limitations of Section 181 of the German Civil Code [BGB].

DHB is authorised to grant its employees sub-power of attorney with the requirement that declarations on legal transactions on behalf of NORD/LB must be signed at all times by two employees of DHB with sub-power of attorney (joint representation).
