Christoph Dieng joined the Managing Board of Norddeutsche Landesbank Girozentrale (NORD/LB), Hanover on 3rd February 2017 as Chief Risk Officer, CRO.

He is responsible for Credit Risk Management, Shipping Portfolio Optimisation, Risk Controlling, Special Credit Management, Economic/Research divisions and LFI Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania.

His responsibilities also include the Relationships for Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania and United Kingdom / London Branch.

Mr. Dieng was born in 1967 in Bad Schussenried. After completing a bank apprenticeship at Hypovereinsbank AG in Ulm, he studied business administration in Pforzheim from 1989 to 1993.

In 1993 he joined Deutsche Bank where he completed a trainee program before holding various Relationship Management positions in Corporate Finance and Corporate Banking in New York and Munich. In 1999 Mr. Dieng moved to Deutsche Bank's Risk Management and held several leadership positions in London, Geneva and Frankfurt, finally as European Head of Credit Risk Management Global Corporates and Institutions.

In 2007 he was appointed Chief Credit Risk Officer at NORD/LB Group with the responsibilities for Credit Risk Management and Credit Portfolio Management.

Mr. Dieng joined the Managing Board of NORD/LB Group as Chief Risk Officer in 2017.
