Günter Tallner is a member of the Management Board of NORD/LB Norddeutsche Landesbank Girozentrale since 3rd February 2017.

Mr. Tallner is responsible for Corporate Banking, Maritime Industries, Aircraft Financing, Corporate Finance, Commercial Properties, Loan & Business Management and the Relationship Management for Americas/New York Branch.

Mr. Tallner was born 1962 in Nuremberg/Bavaria. From 1981 to 1989, he studied law and economics at the University/Erlangen-Nuremberg, abroad at Kalamazoo College/USA, Université de Lausanne/Switzerland and at London School of Economics/Great Britain. He graduated with the First State Examination in Law at the Bavarian State Ministry of Justice and an MBA degree at the University of Bradford/Great Britain.

His career started 1990 at the Dresdner Bank AG. He worked as a corporate client relationship manager and in various functions such as Sales Management and project manager of the integration project „Allianz-Dresdner Bank“. In 2002 Mr. Tallner became Managing Director of Business Development and reported directly to the Management Board. From 2003 to 2006 he headed a Sales department in Rhineland.

In January 2007 Mr. Tallner changed as Managing Director for Corporate Customers to the regional branch Frankfurt at Commerzbank AG. In preparation for Executive he led various projects in 2012. From January 2013 he worked as Head of Corporate Banking for the region key accounts North-Western-Germany and from February 2015 Corporate Banking of medium-sized businesses North for Commerzbank AG. Furthermore he was responsible for Corporate Banking in Scandinavia and the Competence Centre of Energy with worldwide activities.

Mr. Tallner exercises various mandates. He is Deputy Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Deutsche Hypovereinsbank AG (Hanover) and of NORD/LB Luxembourg S.A. Covered Bond Bank (Luxembourg).

He is also a member of the Committee for International Business of the Association of German Public Sector Banks (VÖB, Berlin) and the Main Committee of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC, Cologne).

Mr. Tallner is Consul of the French Republic since December 2018.
